Description

The 2-ya Tverskaya-Yamskaya 28 clubhouse is located in the prestigious Tverskoy District of Moscow's Central Administrative Okrug, at 28 2-ya Tverskaya-Yamskaya Street. The building was constructed in 2004 by the developer Trest-1991 as part of a custom project from the "Luzhkov era." It is a low-rise, monolithic brick complex of 7-8 stories.

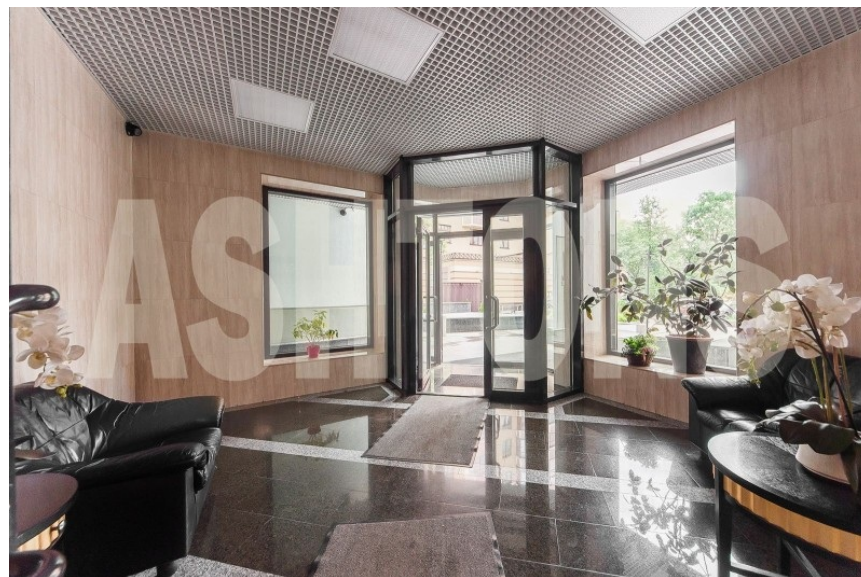
The building's architectural design is characterized by a restrained classical style with elements of post-Soviet luxury housing. The facades are plastered in light green and yellow tones, and the basement is clad in gray granite. The windows feature brown wooden double-glazed units, and semicircular loggias with panoramic glazing are included. The building is equipped with high-speed KONE elevators and a garbage chute.

The building's infrastructure and security are top-notch. The complex is fenced and guarded 24/7. Video surveillance is provided along the perimeter, video intercoms are installed, and a concierge service is available. There is a two-level underground parking garage with elevator access directly to the apartment. The surrounding area is landscaped, with lawns, trees and flowers, and a relaxation area.

The building's location provides exceptional transport accessibility and access to all the infrastructure of the capital's city center. Mayakovskaya metro station is just 400 meters away, or a 5-minute walk. Belorusskaya and Novoslobodskaya metro stations are also within a 700-meter radius. Nearby attractions include Tverskaya Street, the Garden Ring, and numerous theaters, museums, and concert halls. School No. 128, the Magnolia store, and the promenade area of Miussky Square are also within walking distance. Thanks to its proximity to the city center, residents can quickly reach the Kremlin, the business center, and all key points of the capital.
