

Cottage settlements

Cottage Village "Knyazhye Ozero"

Moscow, Novorizhskoye Highway, 23-27 km from MKAD, Istra Urban District, Moscow Region



Description

The elite cottage village "Knyazhye Ozero" is one of the most famous and award-winning suburban real estate projects in the Moscow region. The village is located on the Novorizhskoye Highway — one of the most prestigious directions. The total territory of the village is 152 hectares, on which more than 500 residential properties are located, suitable for year-round living.

The architecture of the village is designed in a unified European style with classical elements and medieval motifs. The houses are built using three types of construction: traditional brick, warm ceramic block (stone), and Canadian wood-frame technology. The plots are framed with wrought-iron fencing, the streets are illuminated with lamp posts, and the sidewalks are paved with tiles.

The main natural attraction of the village is a cascade of clean lakes with a landscaped embankment. In summer, there is a sandy beach with loungers and a pier; in winter, the lake turns into an ice skating rink. The village territory includes nine hectares of park areas, divided into three thematic zones: "Lake Group," "Grafsky Ponds," and "Park of Changing Eras."

The village is a gated community: access is provided through guarded checkpoints with barriers, a perimeter video surveillance system is installed, 24/7 security and horse patrols are maintained. There is also its own voluntary fire brigade.
