Description

The Ostozhenka 11 residential complex is a luxury clubhouse built in 2009 based on designs by the renowned architectural firm Sergey Kiselev & Partners. The building is a monolithic brick complex of varying heights (4-6 stories) consisting of five sections. The building contains 38 apartments—two per floor in each section—while the upper floors feature more spacious units with terraces, including two penthouses.

The building's facades are clad in German Jurassic limestone, while the courtyard is clad in natural stone and Brazilian garapa wood. The entrance areas are finished with marble, artificial stone, and precious woods. The building is equipped with KONE elevators, supply and exhaust ventilation, air conditioning, and water purification systems.

The amenities include a two-level underground parking garage with 94 spaces, 24-hour security with video surveillance, concierge service, and enclosed grounds with a landscaped courtyard.

The building's location in the Golden Mile provides easy access to key city centers: Kropotkinskaya metro station is 400 meters away, along with the Cathedral of Christ the Savior, the Pushkin State Museum of Fine Arts, Muzeon, Prechistenskaya Embankment, and numerous restaurants, boutiques, and prestigious schools. Ostozhenka 11 is a cozy home for those who value privacy, status, and living in the heart of the capital.
